

Information needed to start the process to request Behavior Analysis Services

1. Referral for Behavior Analysis Services from the recipient's PCP, Neurologist, and/or Psychiatrist.

- 2. Consents (which will be provided by our agency).
- 3. A Comprehensive Diagnostic Evaluation

Comprehensive Diagnostic Evaluation Requirements:

A Comprehensive Diagnostic Evaluation (CDE) is a thorough review and assessment of the child's development and behavior using national, evidence-based practice standards, which may include:

- Parent or guardian interview
- Teacher assessment
- Diagnostic testing using tools such as:
 - Autism Diagnostic Observation Schedule (ADOS-2)
 - The Childhood Autism Rating Scale 2nd edition (CARS2)
 - Modified Checklist for Autism in Toddlers, Revised (M-CHAT-R)
 - Communication and Symbolic Behavior Scales (CSBS)
 - Autism Diagnostic Interview, Revised (ADI-R)
 - Social Communication Questionnaire
 - Battelle Developmental Inventory- 2nd edition
- Hearing and vision testing
- Genetic testing
- Neurological and/or other medical testing

The CDE must be led by licensed practitioners qualified to assess child developmental disorders such as:

- Developmental Pediatricians
- Child Neurologists
- Child Psychologists
- Child Psychiatrists
